

MINUTES OF EMERGENCY MEETING HELD ON 01.02.2026

An Emergency Meeting of the Members of RWA was held on 1st February 2026 at the Mandir premises of Parsvnath Paradise to discuss the importance of Construction of a Community Centre for the residents of this society. The President of RWA in his speech emphasised upon the need of a Community Center in the society. As Promoter, builder and landowner have not taken any care of our needs for a Community Centre for the residents of this society nor they have taken any interest to handover this society to GDA/GNN in spite of repeated correspondence with them, RWA has taken up a stand to build a Community Centre of our own. After much deliberation, it was unanimously decided upon to construct a Community Centre at space available in the STP AREA of our society. The available land parcel measures about 65'x22' =1430 sq. ft. In the proposed community hall, the residents will have a recreation cum library room, where the elderly residents can spend their leisure time happily. Residents can use the available space for holding small functions and gathering also (Terms and conditions will be decided in the GBM in due course). To start with the project, it was decided to form a Committee of residents (who are not defaulters in paying monthly maintenance charges). Residents who volunteered themselves are; 1. This group will prepare the design and layout of the proposed Community Centre. They will assess the costs for construction work and other factors in consultation with RWA. All Members of the Executive Committee of RWA will assist to execute the project. Arrangements for fund raising will be initiated by RWA and residents of Parsvnath Paradise. On the demand of Members present in the meeting, it was decided to fill up two vacant posts of two female Members by selection. All Members unanimously proposed the name of Smt.
